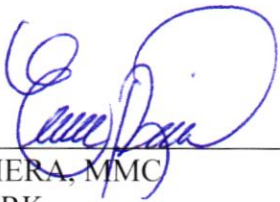
5. SEATING OF ELECTED OFFICIALS

Mayor Davis adjourned the meeting at 6:15 p.m.

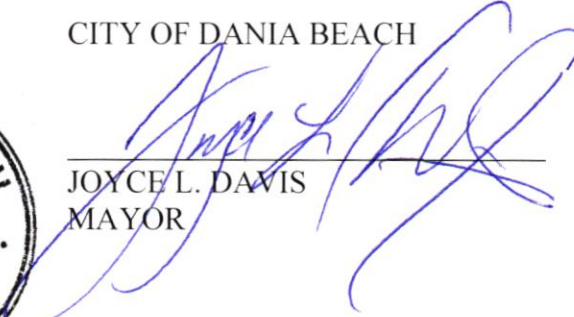
